Award categories

There are five categories designed to reflect the many ways productivity shows up in real life:

- **Why Didn't We Do This Sooner?**

A simple improvement that made work clearer, faster or less painful and just became the new normal.

- **One Small Change, Big Difference**

A small, smart change that delivered outsized results, saving time, reducing friction or making work easier for everyone. No overhaul required. Just a great idea done well.

- **Collaboration That Delivered**

A team who worked across roles, departments or organisations and delivered something better together than they could alone.

- **Wellbeing That Works**

An approach that genuinely improved wellbeing and performance, showing that looking after people is good for business.

- **Developing Talent That Sticks**

People, programmes or practices that helped others build skills, grow faster and actually want to stay.
